ECFI IN A NUTSHELL

ECFI is a collaborative initiative committed to strengthening and promoting the community foundation movement in Europe. The initiative has been hosted by the German Association of Foundations since its inception in 2016.

ECFI's approach is to empower those operating in the community foundation field - community foundations (staff, board members, and volunteers) and the array of support organisations that operate at national and regional level.

WHAT ECFI DOES

ECFI works with community foundations (CFs) and community foundation support organisations (CFSOs), primarily through facilitating and stimulating cross-national interactions and dialogue to enable learning, knowledge-building, sharing experiences and practices of CFs and other philanthropy practitioners. ECFI produces practice-based evidence and tools to empower practitioners to deal with challenges in their communities and their organisations (e.g. sustainability, climate action, civic engagement) and to grow mutual solidarity. ECFI is engaged in on-going mapping and analysis of CFs across Europe and in disseminating information that will encourage development of the field. ECFI curates a Knowledge Centre in its website which contains information about the community foundation field and its impact along with practice tools and guides. Finally, ECFI acts as contact point for the community foundation movement in Europe.
