WHAT IS THE UKCF CONFERENCE?

UK COMMUNITY FOUNDATIONS (UKCF) holds a major conference every 2 years. This is a valuable learning forum for UK and international community foundations and support organisations. The conference entitled 'Empowering Communities Together' will take place in Glasgow from September 9-11 2019, and will offer a wide range of sessions, site visits and learning opportunities.

WHAT IS AN ECFI DELEGATE?

In collaboration with UKCF, ECFI is inviting up to 25 participants from European community foundations or national support organisations to join the conference as ECFI Delegates.

ECFI Delegates will have free access to the whole conference and can expect an allowance for travel reimbursement and accommodation up to €300 where required and on submission of receipts. ECFI Delegates will meet in advance of the conference on Monday, September 9, from 9.30 to 11.30 to discuss individual learning expectations and to learn from each other. Details about this will be shared after approval of the application.

ECFI Delegates will join the conference as participants who will share learnings with each other and afterwards with their national peers.

HOW CAN YOU BECOME AN ECFI DELEGATE?

You can apply to be an ECFI Delegate by completing a simple application form <https://forms.gle/HieNAu2Xp9vTgDuj9>. The deadline for applications is June 20, 2019, 24:00. ECFI will review all the applications and inform you of the outcome no later than June 28, 2019.

We will endeavour to bring a diverse and representative group. Selected delegates will be responsible for registering for the event on the conference website (<http://conference.ukcommunityfoundations.org/>) and making their own travel and accommodation arrangements. The conference organiser can recommend options for accommodation.

ECFI Delegates should arrange to arrive on September 8 and will also be required to participate in an ECFI Delegate meeting prior to the conference.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I AM NOT ACCEPTED AS AN ECFI DELEGATE BUT WANT TO JOIN THE CONFERENCE AS AN INTERNATIONAL PARTICIPANT?
